April was a transition month due to the leadership change at Post 313. With this said, much has occurred at your post. For starters, the July 4th Pancake Breakfast planning is in full swing headed up by Post 313 member Eric Zarko. Eric has been instrumental in this roll in previous years. There was a meeting April 3rd with major players from many involved organizations, including Post 313 in attendance. So far, everything is on track. If you haven't attended the July 4th Pancake Breakfast in previous years you are missing out. It is a throwback to years past as a small town and guests gather together (1100+), to eat breakfast at long tables outside and then watch a small town 4th of July parade go by. It is truly an event difficult to find in today's world. As a resident of Larkspur, it is by far my family's favorite local event.

We are just starting with small hall upgrades. If you came to the Commander's Dinner, April 17th, you might have noticed that the hall is a little better illuminated. This is due to the complete replacement of the light bulbs in the chandeliers. Formerly, we had probably six different types of light bulbs. Some 40W, some 60W, some clear, some frosted, two different shapes. If you looked at them long enough you might have become a little dizzy. We now have 60W soft white candelabra bulbs throughout all six chandeliers (36 in total). It looks much nicer and more professional. There will be more smaller hall projects like this in the months ahead. These small projects add up and along with the larger projects (landscaping and exterior painting) we hope to have a first class establishment where

our members can gather.

Lastly, what you are reading: this newsletter. I have been on a focused campaign to reduce the paper mailing of the newsletter where possible.
