## **Honoring Our Marin Veterans Project**

We recently received the following from a sophomore at Drake High: "I recently took over the administration of the *Honoring Our Marin Veterans* oral history project from the founder, Nick Elsbree, who is now away at college. His mother, Mary Elsbree, will remain active with the project and will act as adult supervisor.

As you may be aware, *Honoring Our Marin Veterans* is a student run project that records oral histories of Marin veterans and active duty personnel. To date, almost two hundred veteran oral histories have been completed. The videotaped interviews are sent to the Library of Congress Veteran History Project. Written narratives are prepared from the interviews and copies provided to the veterans. In addition, the narratives are posted on the project website: <a href="www.honoringmarinveterans.org">www.honoringmarinveterans.org</a>, displayed at the annual Marin Veteran's Day celebration hosted by Building Better Citizens for America, and sent to the Marin History Museum for permanent storage and archival.
