nations to The Marines Memorial Club for a Gold Star Parents gathering and to the Fort Miley Veterans Hospital for volunteers there. We have in the past supported Fisher House to provide housing for families of troops receiving medical care. We have provided aid to veterans needing assistance in transit through the local area. We represent Veterans and provide wreaths at celebrations on Memorial Day and Veterans Day. Sometimes we help provide a Color Guard for these days as well.

We support American troops deployed overseas through care packages to Iraq, Afghanistan, Bahrain, Korea, Kuwait, and some locations so remote they are undisclosed. We sponsor students who attend California Boys State from Redwood High School to learn about democracy and government. And passively, we provide facilities for the community and local non-profits including The City of Larkspur, Redwood High School, Boy Scouts, Kentfield Schools Foundation, Twin Cities Preschool, Marin Highlanders, North Bay Aquatics, SPARK!, Sun Valley Elementary School and others. The Post 313 Auxiliary has provided wreaths for important Veterans days, as well as sponsoring Pauline's birthday and participating in parades.

And we are considering other activities to support the community and American values in the future, including a medical supply disaster trailer to be sponsored by and located near Post 313. We are also considering including a California Boys State representative from Tamalpais High School.

Altogether, you see that Post 313, through the sustained efforts of its members, provides a large number of services that support the American Legion's goals of serving and supporting our Armed Forces, Veterans, and their families, and promoting patriotism in the community.
