November 1919 – American Legion 100th Centennial

San Francisco is remembering the American Legion through a Centennial chronology on display through Dec. 20th at the San Francisco War Memorial Veterans Building. The exhibit includes a timeline for the American Legion and artifacts from several conflicts. The American Legion War Memorial Commission manages the building which is home to several Veterans organizations.

It was the First World War and the return of thousands of Veterans from that war that led to the founding of the American Legion in 1919. Through December 19, there is also an exhibit, The Great War: WWI: The American Experience, in Room 102 M-F 1-6 pm about the American Expeditionary Forces (AEF) honoring men and women from Northern California who served at home and in France.
