There are still only about 220 cases of the Coronavirus19 in Marin County, and of those, over 100 have recovered. health and safety of having 1200 young men gathered at Cal State Sacramento in June were not feasible. However, our Post 313 Boys State selectees will receive a certificate indicating that they were eligible and chosen to attend Boys State.

Meanwhile, thanks to Bob Rogers who has been repairing tile in the bar room and examining the floor boards. We had previously replaced tiles near the end of the bar, but other tiles were cracking, and Bob is replacing them and investigating the cause. We have also had to provide reductions or relief for our rental tenants, recognizing the difficulty they have in conducting business. However, we still have some reduced income coming in and hope that we can see a return to normal revenues in the near future. The Post, in view of these rental losses, also applied for the small business fund to offset economic losses and may receive some additional revenue. Thanks to our Office Manager Leslie Barker for undertaking the SBA economic aid package.

We have been having a Zoom meeting for Post members on Tuesday at 10 am, and expect to continue this during the Shelter in Place orders. You can find this meeting at Meeting ID: 879 6642 5127 .

We also want to thank all the Doctors and Nurses, the Firemen and EMTs, and the Active Duty and National Guard who have stepped up to work tremendous hours and shifts in hospitals, testing sites, and food banks.
